Behavioral supports (through the Medicaid waivers), Counseling services, Music Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Recreational Therapy, and Speech Therapy will continue to be provided via telehealth options through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Our therapists are continuing to work diligently to be available via telehealth and will continue to communicate with individuals regarding those options.
